HEALTHY LIVING INFORMATION

CARS AND ACTIVITY

Leaving your car at home for a short journey is not only good for the environment, it may be better for your health. Adding small amounts of activity to your everyday like this can make a difference.

JUICES FOR CHILDREN

Juices are not good substitutes for whole pieces of fruits or vegetables because:-

- × Whole pieces of fruit and veggies have higher levels of many vitamins, minerals, antioxidants and fibre.
- × It is easy to drink too much juice / over consume juice. 1 popper of juice is equal to 2 pieces of fruit in energy, which can lead to over eating.
- × Too much juice can lead to diarrhoea.
- × Whole pieces of fruits and veggies are richer in antioxidants. These nutrients can help protect against heart disease and specific cancers

Always dilute juices with half water and limit to no more than 1 glass a day.
