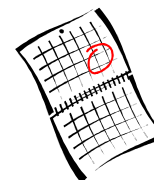

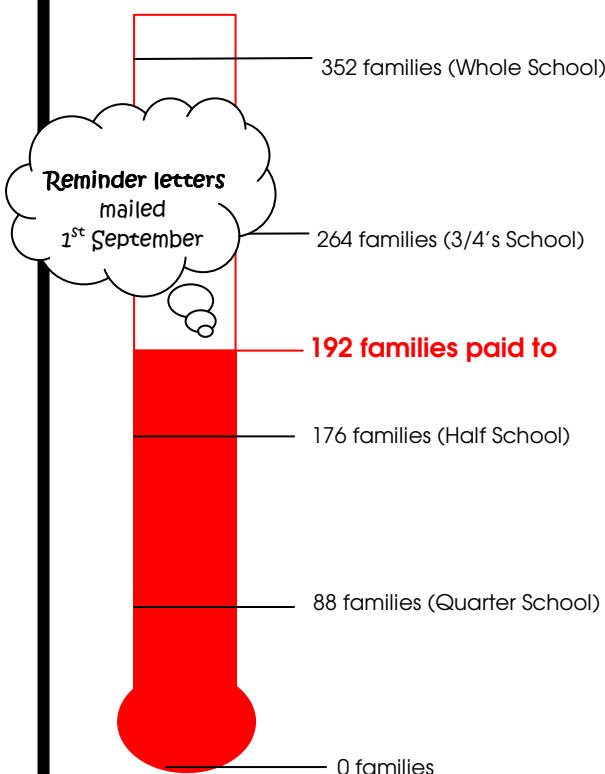

WRPS – OUR “SPACE ODDITY” TICKET SALES

Please find following clarification on the purchasing of tickets. We hope that these points will answer many of your questions.

- Ticket prices - Auditorium Adult \$10/Child \$5. Mezzanine (upstairs) Adult \$15/Child \$8
- A CHILD is classified as a high school student or an under school age child (under school age may also sit on parents lap at no cost - do not require a ticket)
- Week 1 – 31st August to 4th September – sale of reserved tickets - 2 per family
- Week 2 – 7th September - all remaining tickets go on sale until sold out – no limitations
- Split families – please be aware that the 2 reserved seats per family will have to be shared (additional seats can be purchased in week 2)
- A seating plan will be in place and you will need to choose tickets from a plan
- Tickets will not have names on them just seat numbers
- Tickets go on sale 8.30am-10.30am in the school office foyer (extra helpers during this time slot), please queue where indicated
- Tickets also available 8.30 to 3.00 each day from the school office
- Cash or cheque made out to ‘cash’ only (Please do not make cheques payable to the school)
